Cleaning and Maintaining Baby Change Stations

Cleaning and maintaining your baby change stations regularly is essential to maintain a safe environment for children and their carers.

Maintaining a clean and functional baby change station is just a matter of a few simple steps.

- **1.Regular inspection**: Inspect the baby change station to ascertain condition and maintenance requirements. Applying regular hygiene measures, like a maintenance/cleaning schedule, will minimise any potential problems.
- Check that the baby change station opens and closes smoothly.
- Ensure the hardware is tight and that the baby change station is properly secured to the wall.
- Ensure that the baby change station has both ends of a non-frayed strap and that the buckle clicks closed.
- Check that any bed liner dispensers are well-stocked.
- Check that both the interior and exterior surfaces aren't damaged.
- *Immediately take the unit out of service if any component is missing or damaged.
- **2.Prepare your cleaning materials**: You'll need a clean damp cloth/sponge or soft brush, mild neutral pH soap or detergent, a disinfectant, and warm soft water, along with any personal protective equipment (PPE) you may require.
- **3.Wipe the baby change station**: Start by rinsing the baby change station with warm water to remove loose dirt and debris. This will prepare the surface for cleaning.
- **4.Clean the baby change station**: Gently wipe the baby change station with the soapy cloth/sponge or soft brush, paying attention to areas where marks may be present.
- *On stainless steel exterior models, follow the direction of the grain for best results and avoid using excessive amounts of liquid near the edges.
- **5.Rinse and dry**: Once the baby change station is clean, rinse it thoroughly with clean water to remove any soap residue. Use a soft absorbent cloth to dry the baby change station completely to ensure that streaky marks aren't left behind.
- **6.Disinfect the change area**: Use a ready-to-use disinfectant wipe product or apply a disinfection solution to a cloth then wipe over the change area.

All disinfectant cleaning products need to be applied for the specified contact time, as per the manufacturer's instructions.



- On not use abrasive cleaners or drag rough items across the surface and be aware of grit trapped under other materials. This will spoil the finish and can cause scratches.
- On not put hot objects directly on the surface. Prolonged exposure to high temperatures may damage the surface.
- On not rub with steel/wire wool or a metal brush or scrape with steel tools. This can scratch the surface.
