Cleaning and Maintaining Glass

Proper care and maintenance of Metlam Australia glass mirrors will keep them smudge- and scratch-free.

(1) Guidelines for day-to-day upkeep

Before commencing any cleaning regime, remember to disconnect any electrical cables.

Metlam Australia glass mirrors look best when cleaned regularly. Frequent wiping with a soft lint-free cloth or microfibre towel will remove dust, smudges, fingerprints, and other marks.

Wipe water or spilled liquids right away. This can affect the finish if left for a prolonged period.

Simply clean your glass mirrors with warm soft water and a clean soft cloth or paper towel.

If possible, leave a window ajar or use an exhaust fan to allow moisture to escape the room. This is to keep glass mirrors from "sweating" which can eventually lead to damage.

O not use abrasive cleaners or drag rough items across the surface and be aware of grit trapped under other materials. This can cause scratches.

O not use acid, alkali, abrasive, or concentrated ammonia-based cleaning products. They will attack the glass surface and edges.

Using incorrect cleaning products/methods can damage your Metlam Australia Antimicrobial product and void the Metlam Australia Warranty.

(2) Repairing wear and tear

If there is a stubborn mark, use a clean damp cloth or sponge or an old toothbrush to scrub away the debris before washing.

A glass cleaner such as Windex or similar products may be used sparingly but should be applied to a cloth rather than sprayed directly on the glass.
