


Installation Guidelines

- May be subject to Australian Building Code Regulations for height and location fixing and may be subject to placement as per architectural drawings. In all cases, this is the responsibility of the installer.

- Fixings and anchors are not included with the units and are the responsibility of the installer to appropriately fix the unit to the wall.

- Remove wall mount from the cover by undoing the set screw on each cover. Keep the set screws aside.
- Use Figure 1 (refer to drawing below) and the holes on the mounting bracket as a guide to mark the holes.
- Ensure that the marks are level before you drill the holes, and mount the brackets using the appropriate fixings (not included).
- Use Figure 2 (refer to drawing below) as a reference to cutdown the ends of the tube to match measurement A (if required).
- File down any sharp edges before placing the plastic collar on each end of the tube.
- Insert the wall mount covers into the open ends.
- Tighten the tension bolt on the inside of the wall mount cover using a torque wrench.
- Place constructed parts of the backrest set over the wall mounts.
- Replace and tighten the set screws from Step 1.
- Use remaining fixings provided to attach the PVC pad to the backrest set, aligning the pad to the centre of the pan.
- Check that the unit is level and secure to the wall to complete installation.





*Drawings depict MLR119MKII Straight Rail Backrest




