

Installation Guidelines


- May be subject to Australian Building Code
 Regulations for height and location fixing and may
 be subject to placement as per architectural
 drawings. In all cases, this is the responsibility of the
 installer.
- Fixings and anchors are not included with the units and are the responsibility of the installer to appropriately fix the unit to the wall.
- Hold the unit on a wall in the desired location, and mark the 8 mounting holes.
- **2.** Secure unit to wall using suitable fixings and ensure that the mounting flange is flat against the wall.
- 3. To finish installation, check that the grab rail moves easily from the horizontal position to the upright position. Ensure that the grab rail does not fall down when in the upright position.
- 4. Apply a small amount of pressure to release the grab rail from upright position and lower it back to the horizontal position.

Operation

 Grab rail can be lowered into a horizontal position when in use, and folded into an upright position for storage.

 Grab rail comes pre-tensioned, can be tensioned as desired using an Allen Key.
