Installation Guidelines

Step 1: Please refer to the architectural drawings for required product placement and height. **UNIT MUST BE ATTACHED TO A SOLID WALL OR IN-WALL SUPPORT.**


Step 2: Locate the x 4 mounting holes on the back of the unit. Based on the installation height required, mark the 4 mounting points on the wall. Please check the mounting hole measurements as slight variations may occur due to manufacturing tolerance.


Step 3: Using a drill, drill x 4 mounting holes in the marked locations on the wall.

Step 4: Drive the x 4 M8 90mm expansion bolts provided into the drilled mounting holes.

Step 5: Open the front of the mirror to approx. 45°. Using 2 people, lift the mirror cabinet and slowly align it with the expansion bolts on the wall.

Step 6: After placing the unit over the expansion bolts, secure the unit with nuts to complete the installation.

How to Replace the Soap and Battery on the ML_IMC2_SS

Requirements:

- Battery Size: 4 x 'C' Battery.
- Soap: A Commercial Grade Liquid Soap with a Viscosity range of 100-3800cps (centipoises) and a PH level between 6.50 9.00 should be used in this dispenser to ensure the dispenser performs at an optimal level.

A) Battery Installation & Replacement:



Step 1: Loosen the left and right fixing nuts.



Step 2: To remove the soap dispenser slide it in an upwards direction.



Step 3: Slide the battery compartment cover off in the direction of the arrow.

Step 4: Replace the battery with x 4 'C' size battery.

Step 5: Please move the lever upward to turn off and downward to turn on, following the upright position of the soap unit.



Step 6: Reinstall the soap dispenser.



Once installed in the unit, the battery compartment and on/off switch will be located here.

B) Replacing the liquid soap:

Step 1: Open the lid and pour in the liquid soap.

Please note the image to the right showcases the suggested minimum amount of liquid soap required.
